For those of you made it to La Crosse for the fall convention, thank you. For those that submitted images for the "Best of N4C" with your Member ID# somewhere on the print or slide thank you again, as it made our job scanning and organizing the images very easy.

With that said, please ask your N4C Contact for your Member ID# and start noting it on your submissions. It is actually REQUIRED this year and this simple addition makes the judging club's life easier and it really makes record keeping for year end points simple. Imagine seeing a contest report listing Robert Jones as the winner in contest "A", and Bob Jones as the winner in contest "B" and yet another form with R.M. Jones as a winner in contest "C". Now is this one person, or father and son, or cousins, or not related at all? Yes the member club gets the points, but Robert, Bob and R.M. each get their own points.

The process of assigning member numbers is done at the club level and is described in the Contest Rules. Ken Johnson maintains the master list for N4C. Questions or updates can be directed to him at email web@n4c.us. The complete general contest rules are available on the web http://n4c.us/competition.htm.

Now if the images AND THE CONTEST REPORT FORM listed the MEMBERS ID#, then life would be good for all. (See points 6, 7 & 13 of the General Rules). There is a NEW easy to use "Contest Judges Report" form that is on the N4C website (on the "Supplies & Forms" page).

On another contest note, General Rule #20 & 22 states that, "The Chair of the Judging Committee shall not serve as a judge or jurist." Now in all of my years of judging, I know that things happen at the last minute, so please think about asking for an alternate judge, when getting volunteers to judge.
