N4C Convention Summary

2013 Convention Chair Sheila Sutton

The Southwest Iowa Shutterbugs Camera Club hosted the N4C (North Central Camera Club Council) Fall convention at Supertel Inn and Convention Center in Creston, October 3-5, 2013.

Late afternoon on Thursday, the photographers took a tour of Mt. Pisgah just south of Lorimor. They were fascinated by the information that Bob Brown shared with us and had no idea there was such a rich and interesting history found right here in our rural community. After the tour, we enjoyed a bonfire and roasted our own hot dogs and s'mores for supper before heading back to the hotel for more socializing and catching up with new and old friends.

Friday may have started out rainy but the spirits of these photographers were not at all dampened. Three different groups went out to shoot the treasures found in our small town. One group braved the clouds and used the wet, rainy weather to their advantage in the salvage yard at Huelett and Sons. Another group headed over to local friend of photography, Dick Anderson's garage filled with Antiques and other interesting objects. We heartily thank Dick for offering us this 'indoor option' that very morning. Those who chose that were pleasantly surprised with the joy of the hunt among the treasures. The last, and largest group made their way to the Union County Historical Complex found at McKinley Park. They were greeted by volunteers dressed in vintage clothing in the print shop, the farmhouse, the schoolhouse, and the church along with all the other buildings. The photogs LOVED every opportunity found in this local treasure from the big red barn to the caboose to the sheds filled with vintage implements and a couple extra treats were in store for us when a group of civil war re-enactors allowed photographers to shoot something different. Cameras were traded for guns. They may have been loaded with blanks, but the sound and feel was pretty real. But, if your interests were a little more on the tame side, a team of draft horses was brought in, and hitched up to the covered wagon for an impressive photo opportunity. Remember, all of this is taking place with a slight drizzle to light rain falling around us, just about the time that the clouds opened up with heavy precipitation, thunder and lightning, it was time to head back to the hotel for lunch.

By the time lunch was over, the sky was clear and we were able to go on the afternoon walking tour of downtown Creston without umbrellas. Brian Zachery from Creston:ARTS met us at the Depot Gallery and shared an interesting history of the Depot, and the Gallery. The Shutterbugs were proud to unveil a fine show of Southwest Iowa Shutterbug Photography to their photo friends. The show will be at the gallery for the month of October, and it is open to the public Mon-Fri 11-1, and Sat 1-4. The walking tour started on Adams Street and many photographers armed with camera, tripod, map and a keen sense of direction left on their own to explore the storefronts and alleyways of uptown Creston. Many worked their way North on the streets and regrouped at Maple Street Memories then ended at Holy Spirit Catholic Church.

We returned to the Supertel Conference center for a board meeting open to all N4C members, then a delicious barbeque buffet meal was served by Up In Smoke. After supper the Best of the Best slideshow of N4C digital photo winners from the 2012-2013 competition year was shared.

Saturday was the final day of the convention, but it was packed with lots of talent and information. Our morning speakers included Ryan Brown from Sigma who shared "Secrets of Beginning and Advanced Portraiture". Ty Smedes held session on "Photographing Iowa's Bald Eagles".

Mark Peterson led a workshop on "lighting and using light reflectors and diffusers". John Van-Steenberg of Tamron talked about "Lens Selection and Creating Images with Impact". A short lunch break and then on to the Conference Speaker, Parish Kohanim. Parish is a "Canon Explorer of Light" and having this world famous photographer share his talent, knowledge, and philosophy with us was wonderful.

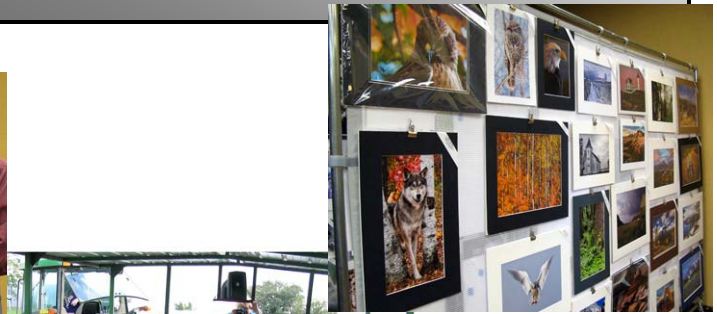
