## President's Message.....

Hi Everyone

It's been a great summer and I am looking forward to seeing you in the fall at the N4C Convention. It is in Hudson, WI and hosted by the Women's Color, Kaposia, and North Metro CCs. They have done an excellent job of putting together great field trips and speakers for us to enjoy. In the last President's message I shared that I was leaving on a photo trip with fellow N4C photographers. Our original purpose was to do a photo tour in the Palouse, eastern Washington farming region. But as I usually do when going to a destination I figure out where else I would like to go on the way out and back. On our way out we stopped in Grand Teton and Yellowstone NPs. That region had had 170% of their normal snowfall and there was still a lot of snow on the Tetons June 1st. We also photographed in Glacier, Theodore Roosevelt, and Badlands NPs. We were on the road for 26 days. It was a long trip, but everyone was very pleased with all that we saw and photographed.

We had a variety of subjects. There were flowers, mountains, wildlife (buffalo, elk, wild horses, deer, meadowlarks, blue birds, etc.), old barns, ghost towns, cattle, and the Palouse rolling hills. One of the really fun experiences was to suddenly find myself in the middle of a modern day Montana cattle drive. I was buzzing 70 mph down a two lane highway when I saw a beat up old pickup with a red flag on a 2x4 stuck out it's window. Right behind the pickup were riders, cattle, and dogs coming down the middle of the highway. The cows and the calves were bawling, because they had gotten separated from each other. I simply stopped, parked the car on the highway and let the cattle drive come to us. Because of the position I was in some of the shooting was through my windshield and other shots out my window. I was surprised that the images shot through the windshield turned out pretty good.

A lot of you have met Lyle Glass from Medora, ND either at Springbrook or at the two N4C Conventions he hosted with the assistance of Fargo-Moorhead CC. We had an opportunity to see and visit with Lyle while we were in Medora. He said he is feeling pretty good, but still has some lost of feeling in one leg. He is volunteering with Boy Scouts to raise and lower the American flag daily in Medora. He is also has a part in the Medora Musical. He continues to spend a lot of time out in Theodore NP photographing the wild horses and the new foals.



Keeping shooting and I will see you in September at the N4C Convention.

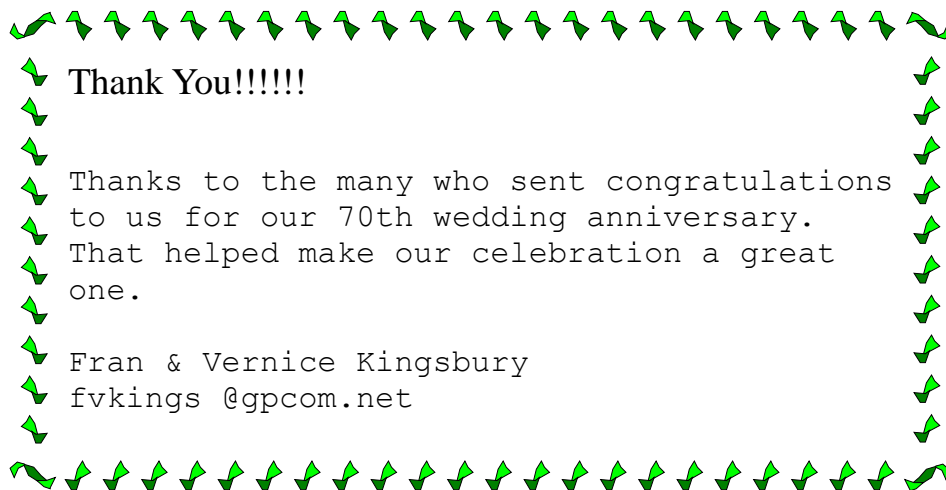

In PSA's Who's Who listings for 2013 that identifies the top international exhibitors - worldwide, two St. Paul CC'ers achieved notable success in the North American section.

Margaret Boike, EPSA was 14th in PID/Projected Image Division and Karen Leonard placed 15th in Photojournalism with an acceptance rate of 3.5 per salon entry and was a known PSA Silver medalist.

PSA's Photojournalism Division Chairman and PJD's International Exhibition Projected Image Chairman John Larson, Jr. APFA, has appointed three St. Paul CC'ers as judging panel members to the upcoming International salon in August - Morris Gildemeister, Gene Schwope, FPSA and Herb Gustafson, Hon.PSA, EPSA.

"A motion was made by Scott Udey, seconded by Debbie Bates, to move Creative Prints and 2 x 2 Slides to every other month, with double entries for both of those, in alternating months, for the year 2014-2015. Motion carried."

Since there will be only four contests, clubs may enter 16 slides in each contest: two slides made by each of eight of their club members. Club Slide Representatives are reminded that "Open" Slides may be Pictorial, Nature, Contemporary, Photojournalism, or Photo-Travel Slides.
