I'm already anticipating Springbrook 2015 and the N4C Convention in Omaha, next fall. Thanks to Diane Darnielle for her past years of work: especially for helping lead us to a rotating, master-judging schedule and the new Digital Black and White contest. Thanks to the board and contest chairs for all of their work, this past year, and for all they will make time for, this year.

I'm sure you are all familiar with the saying, "Be careful what you wish for, you just might get it, or it might not turn out how you think it will." I like the saying, "Be certain what you are working *for*, have a vision and have a plan." Well, I have a vision and I have a plan for reaching that vision. I need *every member* of N4C to help, however. As an educator, I have been trained to set goals or objectives, but one of the new trends in education is to setup clear targets that students can understand and attain. When N4C started, our founders wrote a pretty detailed list of objectives for N4C. You can find a very good condensed version of it on the N4C home web page. I like the fact that we have a purpose statement or what an educator would call a mission statement. That purpose/mission statement is, "N4C is a non-profit organization dedicated to public education and learning in the science and art of photography." With this in mind, I would like to setup some targets for you as N4C members to shoot for.

Target 1: <u>Do your best as a member and a club to model the N4C purpose/mission.</u> I believe that all of you are doing this, but I want to challenge you to look again and see what you can do to raise the bar for yourself and your club. If we can be dedicated to public education and learning in the science and art of photography, I believe good things will happen.

Target 2: <u>Do your best as a club to comment on every contest entry.</u> The scores generated for each image during judging do not tell the photographer the "why this score," as well as words can. The time your club takes to give constructive feedback is critical to each photographer's learning experience, especially on the images that don't win. As an art teacher, I like to acknowledge a positive aspect about the image, before giving suggestions to the artist as to what could be done to improve their work.

Target 3: <u>I wish for everyone in N4C to be a winner.</u> Careful what you wish for, you just might get it. There are a lot of ways that we can all be winners!

With your help, I believe we can reach all three of these targets. I have a vision and a plan. So, my Friends of N4C, go out and shoot for those targets. Have a vision and execute your plan.

The style of new N4C winner galleries has changed and may now be viewed on mobile devices – iPads, Smartphones and others which lack support for the "flash" galleries used in the past. Try them out on mobile and desktop. A couple tips. If you change window sizes on your desktop, refresh your browser to adjust the image size to the new window. To see full resolution 1024x1024px, maximize your window, refresh, then click the "Expand Gallery" icon in the button bar. On an iPad I find the portrait orientation view is best.
