Dear N4C Friends,

If you missed Springbrook, you really missed out on a lot of great programs, photo essays and time with your N4C friends. Thanks to Jo Eland for putting together such inspiring programs and to all the presenters. Thanks also to Larry and Deloris on their handling of the registration and the excellent Springbrook accommodations and food.

The next N4C convention will be in Omaha, Nebraska this September 18 & 19. The Omaha Camera Club has worked hard to put together field trips and presenters that cover a wide range of photography interest. Start planning for this convention now by going to the N4C homepage and clicking on the links below the Focus On Omaha N4C Convention logo. Registrations are due in by August 17.

There were a few board-meeting discussions of interest. The big change for next year is that Springbrook will be on the weekend of April 29, 30 and May 1, which is the free camping weekend. If you are a camper person get your camper space registration in early.

As usual we had a discussion about efforts to increase constructive comments, judging process, and scoring. There was a discussion about whether a score 1 should be handed out only if the piece is out of category although the board didn't move to do anything. There is a concern that harsh scoring may not be necessarily helpful. Let's face it, judging categories of Impact and Composition are very subjective and the third category of Technical can easily bridge the subjective/objective line. If we as an organization uphold our mission statement of being dedicated to public education and learning of the science and art of photography, our continued effort to improve judging and critiquing will go a long way towards encouraging those on the receiving end.

It has been my campaign this year for all images to have comments. The April digital categories had comments on 100% of the 632 images. 564 of 585 of May's entries had comments or 96.4 %. We have done comments on 90.4 % of digital images entered this year. I hope that the print categories have had similar success with comments.

We have reached the end of our competition season and I want to thank everyone for his or her effort. I had a vision and set some targets for us to reach. As lovers of photography most of us are already working on creating next year's winning images and preparing for club meetings. We will celebrate this year's winning images at the Omaha convention and I hope that you are planning on being there.
