Best of the N4C Winners Roundup for the Fall Rapid City Convention

First, Second, Third, and Honorable Mention winners in all categories of the 2016-17 monthly contests are eligible to be judged in the Annual Best of N4C Contest. Merit award winners are NOT eligible.

A preliminary list of all winners through April has been sent to clubs so they can begin rounding up prints and slides.

Black Hills Photography Club is hosting the N4C Convention in Rapid City, SD and has established the **deadline for Prints and 2x2 Slides**.

Entries must be received by 5:00 PM Monday, July 10, 2017 if hand delivered, or **postmarked not later than July 5, 2017 if mailed**.

Eligible **DIGITAL entries** have been saved each month and **do NOT need to be sent**.

IMPORTANT: All prints MUST BE MOUNTED (on a stiff backing) for this annual contest. For loose prints they must be mounted on a stiff backing for year end display at the convention. Secure the loose print to the stiff backing by either double sided tape-across the top edge of the print or hinge them along the top edge so the original print tag can be seen.

The winning PRINTS and 2x2 SLIDE entries are to be mailed to: (NO DIGITAL ones and NO PANORAMA PRINTS)
