New N4C President's Message

Since the N4C 2005 Convention in Des Moines, Iowa, I have taken three photographic tours to California and Oregon. In taking photographs on these tours I have really appreciated the use of digital cameras. I still take slide film pictures on these trips; however, I take many more digital pictures.

On these trips you get out on site early in the morning just as the sun is coming up. Towards evening you also get on site as the sun is going down. On the early morning and late day pictures it is wonderful to be able to check your image on the digital SLR LCD. If the image is not what you want, you can make adjustments with the camera, and you can then retake the picture.

Also with digital image cameras your photo tour director can review your image and make recommendations for improvements for your next image.

I should stress that you need a rigid and steady tripod with a good ballhead for these early morning and late day picture taking situations.

Also I realize that after the sun is up awhile, it is harder to see your image on your digital camera LCD. During the middle of the day I take slide film pictures as well as digital image pictures.

I compete using color slides in the N4C monthly contests, in the Central Illinois Camera Club Association (CICCA) salons and in the Photographic Society of America (PSA) international salons.

Next month in this column I will tell you how I get slides made from my digital images.

Des Moines CC Members Have Great Showing at the Iowa State Fair Photography Salon

The Iowa State Fair Photography Salon is one of the best state fair salons. Every year it keeps growing and getting better. It is one of the most popular exhibits at the Iowa State Fair, which draws 1 million visitors each year. The salon is open 12 hours a day, it is not air conditioned, and almost every minute there are people three, four, five deep surrounding the exhibited photos.

When I first entered the state fair photography salon ten years ago there were about 1500 entries. This year there were 3,568 entries in all divisions submitted by 1,252 photographers. Only 1,059 or 30% of the entries were exhibited. 734 photographers had their photographs exhibited. You were a winner if you had a photo accepted and hung.

Schwope Honored by PSA

Eugene F. Schwope, FPSA, member of the St. Paul Camera Club, was the honored recipient of PSA's Stuyvesant Peabody Memorial Award at the 68th International Conference of the Photographic Society of America held September 3-9, 2006, at the Baltimore Marriott Hunt Valley Inn.

The Stuyvesant Peabody memorial Award is one of seven prestigious PSA awards presented each year. The award recognizes a member of PSA who has contributed to pictorial photography in any field of photographic endeavor (by exhibiting, judging, lecturing, writing, teaching, patents, and processes).

SPCC member **Herb Gustafson**, Hon. PSA, FPSA, PPSA, was the 1989 recipient of the Stuyvesant Peabody Memorial Award.

According to an article in the November 2004 *PSA Journal* written by Russel [sic] Kriete, Patrick H. Peabody originated the award in memory of his father, Francis Stuyvesant Peabody, who stimulated the era of pictorial photography.

Francis Stuyvesant Peabody was a well-known black and white photographer who made his fortune as owner of the Peabody Coal Company in Illinois, and who died in 1922.

His vast 900-acre estate in the suburbs just west of Chicago has been reduced to 90 acres, and is now part of the Forest Preserve District of DuPage County. Peabody's 39-room Tudor style mansion is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The mansion and the grounds (lakes, gardens, and stands of forest) are open to the public, as is the Portiuncula Chapel, a replica of the Chapel of St. Francis of Assisi in Italy, which is now used for weddings.

N4C Founding Father **Francis Kingsbury** and his family as well as the children of **Dr. Robert Cochran**, all of whom attended the charter meeting of N4C 50 years ago in Sioux City, were in attendance at Saturday evening's banquet at the Marina Inn, South Sioux City, Nebraska.

Francis spoke of "A Look Back, Ahead..." He said the N4C slogan "Where Names Become Faces and Faces Become Friends" was written on the back of an old envelope. After many letters written on an old Royal typewriter, 13 members became active in the newly formed N4C—they had one page of rules. Francis continued, "It's fun to look back, but very important to look forward." Young people are needed for the future of camera clubs.

Special Door Prize Won

Robert Tebben of the Sioux Falls Camera Club had his name drawn for the special door prize, which was donated by **Gerald A. Bonsack** of the La Crosse Camera Club.

Gerald explains the "teleidoscope" is a cross between a telescope or camera and a kaleidoscope. If you think of a kaleidoscope, at the end of the mirror section there is an object cell or wheel. That cell or wheel is what is reflected back through the mirrors to your eye. With a camera, the lens system focuses the real world on a film plain. A teleidoscope focuses the real world where the object cell or wheel was and that image is then reflected back through the mirrors.

On **Prints** info must be on the back of the mount in the upper left corner, and category of competition should be clear.
